Tawheed (Islamic Monotheism)



Tawheed in Arabic means the Oneness (of Allah)

Tawheed is to consider and believe in one Allah (the only true God) in his Oneness of Rububiyyah (lordship), His Holy names and qualities, and to believe that He is the Owning lord who only deserves to be worshipped.

Allah Says in the Holy Quran







An Explanation of Surah Al-Ikhlas










There is no one like Allah




The Holy Quran is the Last and Final Words of Allah (God) Almighty and a message to whole mankind.


Allah almighty Says

Verily, this Qur'ân guides to that which is most just and right and gives glad tidings to the believers (in the Oneness of Allâh and His Messenger, Muhammad (**)). who work deeds of righteousness, that they shall have a great reward (Paradise). (Quran Chapter: 17, Verse: 9)



Whats is the Hadith?





Approval (Taqreer):- It implies that while doing something in the presence of the Prophet (ﷺ) and a companion (Sahabi) acted in a particular manner and the Prophet (ﷺ) observed it and did not disapprove it.

The Prophet of Allah is our guide and role model. The only Prophet whose detailes of daily life we have is Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). We have to follow his foot steps.

Asmaul Husna - Beautiful Names (99 Names of Allah)

And (all) the most beautiful names belong to Allâh, so call on Him by them, and leave the company of those who belie or deny (or utter impious speech against) His Names. They will be requited for what they used to do. (Surat Al-A'raf 7:180)

Narrated Abu Hurairah: The Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said, "Allah has ninety-nine names (i.e. one-hundred minus one) and whoever knows them will go to Paradise." (Sahih Al-Bukhari 50:894)



Why has Allah almighty created the mankind?

Allah says in the holy Quran that He did not create all the things without any purpose while He created whole the mankind for the purpose of worshipping Him alone, and without any partner.

Allah almighty Says

And I did not create the jinn and humans except they should worship Me. [Quran Chapter 51: Verse 56]

The prophet Muhammad said:

Allah's right on His slaves is that they should worship Him (Alone) and should not worship anyone besides Him. (Sahih al-Bukhari 2856)

Allah has created whole the mankind, He created the universe for us. This is not our final destination. Allah Says: Who has created death and life, that He may test you which of you is best in deed. (Quran Chapter 67 Verse 2)



Why Allah almighty Sent Prophets and Messengers?

Allah had been sending Prophets and Messengers to His devotees in order to invite them to the worship him alone, to order them not to ascribe partners unto Him and bring them out of the darkness of polytheism and into the light of Monotheism. All the Prophets preached regarding the belief in the Oneness of Allah.

Allah almighty Says

And verily, We have sent among every Ummah (communitynation) a Messenger (proclaiming): Worship Allah (Alone) and avoid (or keep away from) Taaghoot (all false deities etc. do not worship Taaghoots besides Allah. (Quran Chapter 16 Verse 36)

The prophet Muhammad مُثَاثِثُةُ said:

It was the duty of every Prophet that has gone before me to guide his followers to what he knew was good for them and warn them against what he knew was bad for them.(Sahih Muslim 1844)

And no persons, is more fond of accepting an excuse than Allah, on account of which He has sent messengers, announcers of gladtidings and warners. (Sahih Muslim: 1499)





Where is Allah?



It is proven in the holy Quran and Hadith (prophetic teachings) that Allah is above His heavens over His Throne (as befits His Majesty) and that He is the Exalted, Most High. He is above all things, and there is nothing that is above Him.

Allah almighty says

The Most Gracious (Allâh) rose over (Istawâ) the (Mighty) Throne (in a manner that suits His Majesty). [Quran Chapter20: Verse 5]

The prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم said: أَلاَ تَأْمَنُونِي وَأَنَا أَمِينُ مَنْ فِي السَّمَآءِ يَأْتِينِي خَبَرُ السَّمَاءِ صَبَاحًا وَمَسَاءً

Don't you trust me though I am the truth worthy man of the One in the Heavens and I receive the news of Heaven (i.e. Divine Inspiration) both in the morning and in the evening? (Sahih al-Bukhari 4351)



The Arabic word "shirk (شِرْک)" means "to be partners"
It means to believe that there is one who shares with Allah almighty
in his acts, or to believe that the source of power, harm or blessings
is from others besides Allah. Such as partners in worship,
supplication, invocation, sacrifice etc.

Shirk is the greatest sin. Allah says that He will not forgive the sin of shirk.

Allah almighty says

إِنَّهُ مَنُ يُّشُوكُ بِاللَّهِ فَقَدُ حَرَّمَ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ الْجَنَّةَ وَمَا وَاهُ النَّارُ وَمَا لِلظَّالِمِينَ مِنُ أَنصَارٍ

Verily, whosoever sets up partners (in worship) with Allâh, then Allâh has forbidden Paradise to him, and the Fire will be his abode. (Quran Chapter 5 Verse 72)

The prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم said:

عَنُ أَبِيُ هُرَيُرَةُ رَضِىَ اللّٰهُ عَنُهُ، قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ اللّٰهِ صَلَّى اللّٰهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ" قَالَ اللّٰهُ تَبَارَكَ وَتَعَالَى أَنْهُ رَكُ فِيْهِ مَعِي غَيْرِي تَرَكُتُهُ وَشِرُكَهُ" أَنْهُ رَكَ فِيْهِ مَعِي غَيْرِي تَرَكُتُهُ وَشِرُكُهُ"

Abu Hurairah treported Allah's Messenger (Peace be upon him) as stating that Allah the Most High and Exalted said:

I am the One; One Who does not stand in need of a partner. If anyone does anything in which he associates anyone else with Me, I shall abandon him with one whom he associates with Allah. (Sahih Muslim 2985)



Is it permissible to sacrifice for anyone besides Allah?

It is not permissible to sacrifice for anyone besides Allah. Whoever sacrifice on anyone's name other than Allah or associated someones else with Him, committed major Shirk (Shirk Akbar).

Allah almighty says

Say (O Muhammad Peace be upon him): "Verily, my Salât (prayer), my sacrifice, my living, and my dying are for Allâh, the Lord of the 'Alamîn (mankind, jinn and all that exists) (Quran Chapter 6 Verse 162)

The prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم said:

Allah cursed him who sacrificed for anyone besides Allah (Sahih Muslim 1978)



May Allah guide us to the straight Path Aameen.
